Go through the list of 23 NLU's in India and find out how you can secure admission in them along with their course details, fee structure and ranking 2020 and 2019. National Law Universities (NLU's) are India's most prestigious law schools. The first NLU, National Law School of India University (NLSIU), Bangalore was established under the National Law School of India Act, 1986. Currently, we have 23 NLU's in India offering five-year integrated law courses as well as postgraduate and PhD courses in law. Last year, the National Institute of Ranking Framework (NIRF) Report 2020 was released by MHRD in which 10 of the 23 NLU's ranked among the top law colleges in India. The top three positions for law colleges in India were secured by NLSIU Bangalore, NLU Delhi and NALSAR Hyderabad with 78.66 scores, 74.02 scores and 73.12 scores respectively. These NLU's were among the top three law colleges in NIRF Report 2019 as well. However, in 2020 NLIU Bhopal dropped down to 17th position from 11th position in 2019. The rankings for NLU's like RGNUL Patiala, NLU Jodhpur, WBNUJS - Kolkata, GNLU Gandhinagar were changed as well. Read here to know more about NLU's in India. However, for admission to NLU Delhi, aspirants have to clear the All India Law Entrance Test (AILET). NLU Delhi does not accept CLAT score. Also Read: CLAT 2020 question paper with solutions Let us understand the basic difference between both the above-mentioned law entrance exams for NLU admissions: What is CLAT? CLAT is a national-level law entrance exam, conducted for admission to 22 National Law Universities in India (except for NLU Delhi). The law entrance exam is conducted by Consortium of NLU's, the governing body of which includes vice-chancellors of all the 22 NLU's. Through CLAT, admissions are open for more than 2,800 seats for five-year integrated law courses and around 750 seats for postgraduate law courses. What is AILET? All India Law Entrance Test, popularly known as AILET, is the only entrance exam conducted and accepted by NLU Delhi. This national level exam is conducted once a year for admission to the university's five-year integrated LLB and LLM courses. While LLB course offers total 123 seats, LLM course offers total 81 seats. Difference in CLAT and AILET exam pattern for UG courses: Last year, CLAT Consortium made major changes in the exam pattern of CLAT. However, NLU Delhi still continues with its previous exam pattern. Difference in CLAT and AILET exam pattern for LLM courses: The CLAT consortium had removed the 'Descriptive Paper' of CLAT LLM last year due to COVID-19 risk. However, the Consortium has re-introduced the subjective section in the exam this year. On the other hand, the exam pattern of AILET 2021 for LLM courses remains the same as previous years. Eligibility Criteria for NLU Admissions The eligibility criteria for undergraduate and postgraduate law courses offered at NLU's (including NLU Delhi) is as under: Academic criteria for UG admissions: Candidates passed or appearing in the Class 12 qualifying examination are eligible to apply for NLU admissions They must secure at least 45 per cent marks in the qualifying examination if belonging to General/ OBC/ PWD/ NRI/ PIO/ OCI categories For candidates belonging to SC/ ST categories, five per cent relaxation in minimum qualifying marks is given i.e. they should obtain at least 40 per cent marks in the qualifying examination of Class 12 Candidates who completed their Class 12 education from open schools are not eligible for admission to NLU's Academic criteria for PG admissions : Candidates seeking admission to LLM courses offered at NLU's should possess an LLB degree or an equivalent from any recognised law college or university They should obtain at least 55 per cent marks in the qualifying law degree if they belong to General/ OBC/ PWD/ NRI/ PIO/ OCI categories For candidates belonging to SC/ ST categories, the minimum marks required is 50 per cent or an equivalent grade Candidates appearing in the final year examination of their law degrees are also eligible to apply Age limit criteria for NLU admissions : Bar Council of India has removed any upper or lower age limit criteria for admissions to law courses. A: As per NIRF Ranking 2020, NLSIU Bangalore is the best National Law University in India followed by NLU Delhi and NALSAR Hyderabad. Q: How many NLU's are there in India? A: There are total 23 National Law Universities in India. Q: Are all NLU's good? A: NLU's are the most prestigious universities in India when it comes to pursuing law education. All the National Law Universities are affiliated to Bar Council of India (BCI) and recognised by University Grants Commission (UGC). Therefore, as compared to other law schools in the country, NLU's are usually considered better. However, among all the NLU's, some of the best ones (as per NIRF rankings) include: NLSIU Bangalore NLU Delhi NALSAR Hyderabad NLU Jodhpur NLU Kolkata Q: Which law courses are offered at NLU's? A: Law courses that are typically offered at NLU's include: BA LLB BBA LLB BSc LLB BCom LLB BSW LLB LLM MPhil PhD Q: Which NLU offers the cheapest law course? A: RMNLU, Lucknow and HNLU, Raipur have the lowest fee structures for undergraduate and postgraduate law courses offered by them. Q: Is NLU Delhi better than NALSAR Hyderabad? A: As per NIRF rankings 2020 and 2019, NLU Delhi is a better institute than NALSAR Hyderabad. Q: What is the admission procedure at NLU's? A: For NLU admissions in UG or PG law courses, candidates need to appear for national-level law entrance exams such as CLAT and AILET. Q: Can I get admission in NLU without CLAT? A: To secure admission in 22 NLU's (out of the 23 NLU's) across the country, it is mandatory for candidates to appear for CLAT exam. However, for admission to NLU Delhi, candidates do not need to appear for CLAT. Law admissions in NLU Delhi are done through AILET exam. It may be noted that NLU's do not offer direct admission to students. It is mandatory to appear for either of the law entrance exams. Q: Does NLU Delhi accept CLAT? A: No, NLU Delhi does not accept CLAT scores. The institute conducts its own national-level entrance exam, named, AILET. Q: What is the fees of NLU Delhi? A: NLU Delhi admission fee for both UG and PG law courses is nearly Rs 2 lakh for one year. Q: Are NLU's government colleges? A: Yes, all the National Law Universities have been established by an act of the state government. Thus, all the NLU's are state law universities affiliated to BCI and recognised by UGC. Q: Which colleges accept AILET scores? A: Only, NLU Delhi, the conducting body for the exam, accepts AILET scores. Rest all other NLU's accept CLAT scores for UG and PG aw admissions. Q: Who is eligible for a judicial exam in India? A: To apply for lower judiciary services, candidates need to have an LLB degree from a recognised institute/university. The candidates should also be enrolled as advocates under the Advocates Act, 1961. To apply for higher judiciary services, candidates need to have an LLB degree from a recognised institute/university.
